FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the theme for the 2010 parade?

" _____ " is the theme for the first year of the Krewe De Paws. Feel free to explore creative costuming while keeping in mind that we are calling attention to homeless animals in shelters across our area waiting to be adopted into a good home.

How does my dog become a member of the krewe and 'march' in the parade?

Every dog needs to complete a registration form and pay the membership/parade fee. Various levels of membership are available. Doglux membership is \$30 until December 31, and \$40 until January 10th. Day of the event registration is \$50.

Registration can be completed online or by faxing a completed Krewe De Paws 2010 Registration Form (credit card orders only) to (985) 639-3345 -- fax/online registration ends 9PM CST, January 10, 2010. All walking krewe members will receive parade credentials prior to the parade. Make sure to include your complete address including zip code and please write legibly.

What do I receive for my registration fees?

The krewe member will be given credentials and directions regarding their color-coded lineup prior to the start of the parade, a certificate of membership, and food/drink tickets redeemable at Armstrong Park booths day-of-parade. Non-krewe members are not allowed to walk in the parade, but are welcome to enjoy the festivities at the day of parade, 10:30am-'til.

When do the krewe members receive their registration packets?

Packets will be mailed until January 2nd at 5PM -- subsequent registration packets will be at WILL CALL table in the registration area day-of-the-parade. Instant registrations available at:

What forms of payment does the Krewe De Paws accept?

The Krewe De Paws accepts checks made payable to Krewe De Paws, as well as VISA, MasterCard, and American Express. If you choose to register online, please know that our site is secure.

What about the humans with the Krewe members?

Each krewe member's registration includes one human escort. Additional human guests can walk with the krewe member by purchasing an escort pass for \$8. Escort passes can be purchased online, at registration outlets and are available day-of-parade at Olde Towne Registration Desk. Esteemed Levels of registration: Lucky Dog, Leader of the Pack and Top Dog include two, two and four human escorts, respectively.

Where do I go the day of the parade?

Plan to arrive early so that the Krewe member (and the human escorts) have ample time to transition into the proper state of mind for this experience. The pre-parade Party starts at 10:30am. Parking is available throughout Olde Towne. It is easy to walk from any point in Olde Towne. There is plenty of green space to relax and, of course, doggie and people drinks will be flowing along with all the appropriate food items to consume at will. It is the pre-parade Party, so plan to hang and witness the mass of paws take to the streets of Olde Towne and return to Griffith Park, where the Party will continue.

Where can I see the royal court the day of the parade?

The royal court is introduced at the stage prior to the start of the parade lineup. Royalty always leads the parade,

so they are positioned in the front of all canine subjects.

Who receives the proceeds from Krewe De Paws parade and events?

Proceeds from Krewe De Paws will be distributed to a number of organizations dedicated to animal welfare.

How do I buy tickets to the Krewe De Paws Ball?

Tickets for this humans-only ball can be purchased online for \$80 each. Reserved tables of 10 are available for \$1500, and include reserved seating for 10, four passes to VIP reviewing stand at _____ (12noon-5pm), four passes to VIP tent at Griffith Park (10:30-2pm), two signed & numbered posters and two official Krewe De Paws t-shirts. All ball attendees enjoy open bar, food and entertainment. The ball is _____, 2010, 8pm to midnight, at _____.
